

Meet & Greet Day Information

During the meet & greet you and your dog(s) will spend some time here with me to see if my alpha and I are a good fit for your pup(s)! They will romp and play, I will see how they do in a crate, see their potty habits, etc. I do require a meet & greet before being able to make any reservations. I have to see that your dog is fully potty trained, non-aggressive, and able to stay in a crate nicely (used during feeding time). I also want to make sure my environment doesn't stress your dog out. Not all dogs are comfortable in all environments, and it is unfair to any dog to have them stay somewhere that causes extreme amounts of stress.

My schedule is usually very open to be convenient for you. But ideal days would be Tuesdays and Thursdays.

The meet and greet is at my home address.

All you need to bring is yourself, and your dog(s) on a leash, proof of vaccinations and flea prevention. If I don't receive one of the things listed, then we are unable to take your dog inside for a meet and greet and we will reschedule.

Please text when you get here, I will come out and meet you in front yard. Please don't come to the front door or knock/ring the bell can be disruptive for the dogs to hear. Have dogs on leash when you arrive as well. Please try your best to not have dogs go potty in my neighbor's yards.

Here's what to expect when you come drop your pup off for boarding the 1st time!

Texting when on your way is greatly appreciated. Upon arrival, text me to tell me you have arrived, and I will come out front to meet you. Please do not come to the door or ring the doorbell or knock, I'm sure you know how insane your dog goes when someone is at the door. ***Please leave your dog in the car until the handoff has been made of all belongings, contract, payment, and you have made me aware of any care changes. If you have large items (food bins, crates, etc.) please put them on the porch before I come outside or you let your pup out of the car, this makes the drop off process so much easier and streamlined for everyone including your dog.***

I will bring your dog around back to go potty before I let them inside or do anything, please do not let them go potty in my neighbor's yard. Arrive with your dog on a leash.

Payment is due at drop-off. I require it upon drop-off so please have it ready to go, I will send you an invoice the day before drop-off so that your payment can be prepared before your time of arrival.

Please understand that I have a lot of dogs inside and in order to bring your dog in safely, **I have to separate dogs and crate dogs that are crate trained to prepare for your dogs' arrival. So, with that being said, please let us know if you will not be here at your**

scheduled and reserved drop-off or pick-up time. That way we can keep all dogs out and comfortable as long as possible, otherwise they're just waiting and that's not right for them.

What to bring when you drop your pup off at Packlife:

1. Your signed contract (Digital Signed will be checked) I am unable to take your dog in if you do not have your contract signed in all places.
2. Remaining Payment (Prior during Holidays)
3. Food/Treats in labeled Ziploc bags or food bin w/visible name & amount.
Food bowl ONLY if it's **slow feeder**.
4. Collar | Leash/Harness
5. Crate (if dog prefers personal space or in training)
6. Medications or Vitamins labeled w/visible name & instructions

What not to bring when you come to Packlife:

1. Toys
2. Water bowls
3. Sheets/blankets
4. Extra harnesses and leashes
5. Bones
6. Any supplies that are not listed on the list of what to bring.
